The Australian Government has announced the Design and construction of 12 OPV's with construction starting in 2018 in Adelaide , Then In 2020 moving to a Yard in Perth

Future Naval Ship Construction

The Australian Government has announced the Design and construction of 9 Frigates with construction starting in 2020 in Adelaide, BAE Systems Australia has been given first pass approval in the tendering process for the Type 26 Design.
