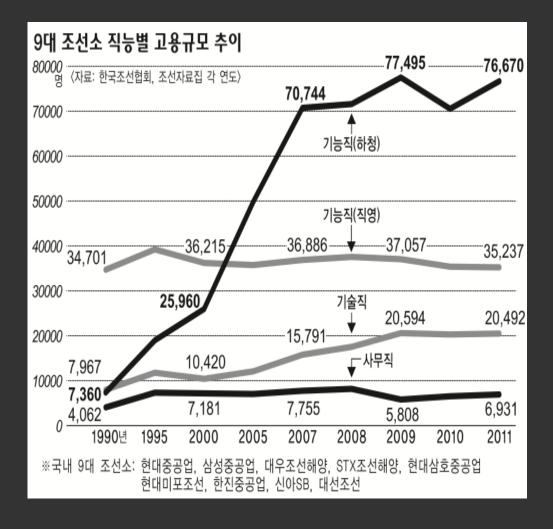

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Current Situation of Precarious Workers in Korean Shipbuilding Industry

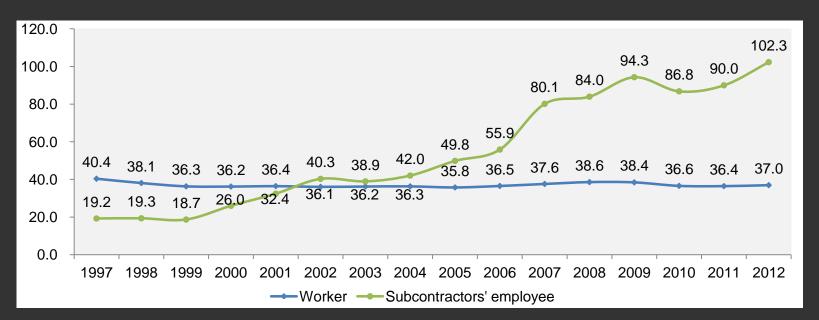

Reasons for Expansion of Subcontracted Workers

- ❖ 자본: 비용 절감 및 탄력적인 인력운용 가능
- ❖ 정규직 노조 : '고용의 안전판'을 확보하는 효과
 - ▷ 그 결과, 2000년대 이후 사내하청 중심의 생산시스템 구축





The Shipyard, an aggregation of all kinds of precarious work

- Subcontracting out of high-intensity, hazardous work
- 위험 작업을 전담하고, 잦은 이동을 하고 있음.
- 원청의 사내하청 노동자에 대한 책임 소홀로 중대재해 빈번
- 산재보험으로 처리하기 보다는 공상처리 강요
- 위험까지 외주화(risk-outsourcing)
- Discrimination in Wages & Benefits
- Restriction of labor rights & constant employment insecurity
- 노동3권 박탈을 위한 현장관리통제

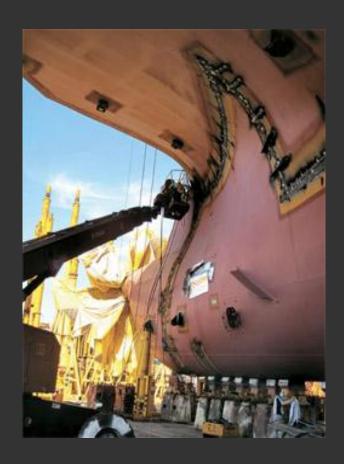
